

Battle Creek Planning Unit Preliminary Staff Concept

MANAGEMENT ACTIONS:

- SURVEY LANDS OUTSIDE THE FERC BOUNDARY FOR BIOLOGICAL RESOURCES
- COORDINATE WITH THE BATTLE CREEK SALMON & STEELHEAD RESTORATION PROJECT & BATTLE CREEK WATERSHED CONSERVANCY
- DEVELOP A NOXIOUS WEED MANAGEMENT PLAN, TERRESTRIAL HABITAT ENHANCEMENT PLAN, OAK WOODLAND MANAGEMENT PLAN, FUELS MANAGEMENT PLAN, FIRE MANAGEMENT & RESPONSE PLAN & MODIFY THE EXISTING FERC RECREATIONAL USE PLAN
- REQUIRE RARE PLANT SURVEYS & IDENTIFICATION OF WILDLIFE CORRIDORS PRIOR TO HARVESTING
- ALTER HARVESTING PRACTICES TO FURTHER PROTECT & ENHANCE HABITAT DURING & AFTER HARVESTING
- DETERMINE HISTORIC FOREST VARIABILITY & PLANT RICHNESS & DIVERSITY
- DEVELOP A YOUTH FISHING PROGRAM IN CONJUNCTION WITH DARRAH SPRINGS STATE FISH HATCHERY
- EVALUATE DEVELOPING TRAILS (HIKING & SNOWMOBILE) BETWEEN NORTH BATTLE CREEK RESERVOIR, BIG LAKE & LATOUR STATE FOREST IN COORDINATION WITH USFS AND CDF
- INVENTORY RECREATION USE ON PLANNING UNIT LANDS & EVALUATE NEED/DEMAND FOR ADDITIONAL FACILITIES
- COMPILE EXISTING CULTURAL RESOURCE INFORMATION, SURVEY REMAINING AREAS & DEVELOP APPROPRIATE PROTECTION MEASURES & INTERPRETIVE MATERIALS

- WORK WITH USES TO RESOLVE BOUNDARY ISSUE
- CONSIDER INSTALLING BEAR BOXES & TRASH CANS
- INSTALL BETTER DIRECTIONAL & INFORMATIVE SIGNAGE AT RESERVOIR

PROTECT SENSITIVE HABITATS FROM HARVESTING & GRAZING

EVALUATE USING THIS PARCEL AS PUBLIC OPEN SPACE/PARK/ OUTDOOR EDUCATION AREA

DEVELOP AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM REGARDING FISH PRODUCTION, LIFE HISTORIES, ETC. WITH LESSEE

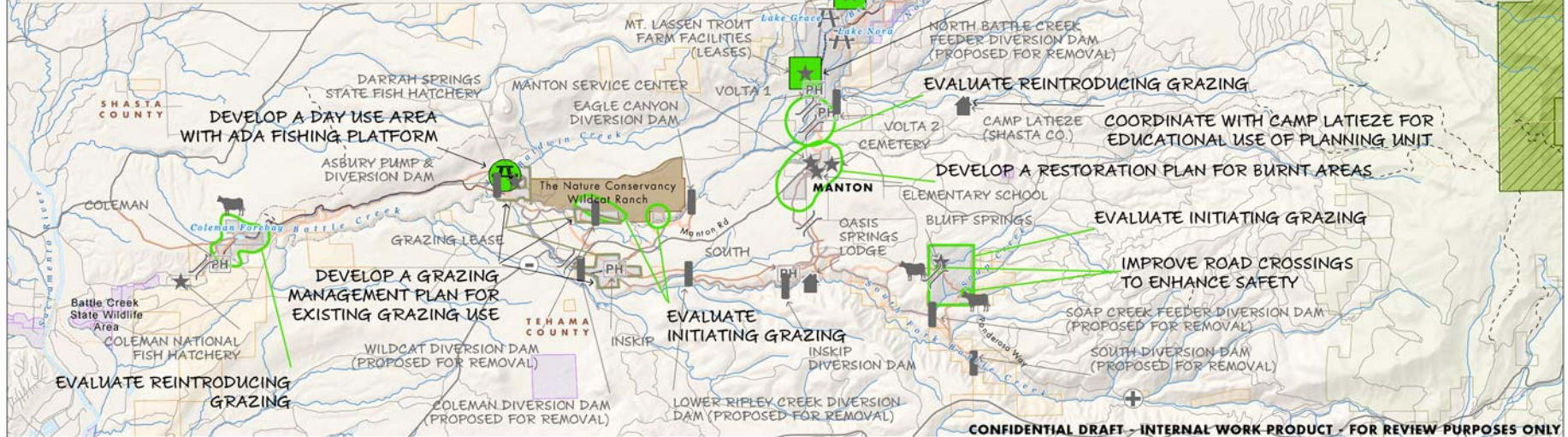
EVALUATE REINTRODUCING GRAZING
